Personality and Interest Understanding:

Humans are the most complex beings on the face of this planet. There are many things that impact the way we behave and react to the circumstances around us. Culture, upbringing, experiences and most importantly our unique personality influence and moderate the way we deal with the world around us. You may realise that the same person reacts differently if the context changes. Therefore, it is critical to understand that human beings evolve over their lifetimes and so does their personality.

Personality is an indicator of how an individual leads, communicates, relates to others, reacts in a particular type of decision or decision making in general. Personality and Interest types:

Type 1 – Action Oriented
